EEDI SUMMER CLUB

Eedi has offered all Year 5 - Year 9 families free access to Eedi Summer Club, an online maths summer programme that is free of charge, and will help to boost your child's confidence in maths ready for the new school year.

Your child will first do a quick placement quiz to set their work and then receive recommended topics that will help them improve the most over 7 weeks. Your child will get unlimited access to review questions, videos and live chat support with real teachers over the holidays. You will also get weekly reports on how they are doing. The minimum recommended work is 1 lesson a week, which should be around 30 minutes of work.

Each week Eedi will hold competitions to boost motivation and engagement, from who has given the most thoughtful explanation to a problem, to what team has the highest amount of points. Plus, there are prizes up for grabs!
