Drowning is amongst one the leading causes of accidental death in the UK and reading the information given on the link will make people safer. It will make them aware of the risks and dangers when around water and gives information on what to do if someone falls into the water or how to help someone who is in trouble in the water.

- 223 people accidentally drowned in the UK in 2019.
- 44% of these people just happened to be near water with no intention of entering the water.
- 82% of these fatalities were male.

As the lockdown restrictions lift it is anticipated that people will look to spend time near water with many of them enjoying staycations. The advice provided will help them spend time in and around water in the safest way possible.

Maths or Physics Internship PAID INTERNSHIP – FOUR WEEKS STARTING MONDAY 21st JUNE 2021

- Carrying out a research project.
- Support of extra-curricular trips, visits and enhancements as appropriate.
- Attending relevant in house training.
- Completing a reflective log.
- Presentation of learning to Partnership Headteachers, senior leaders and peers.
- Physics interns will also carry out laboratory work, including supporting science technicians.
