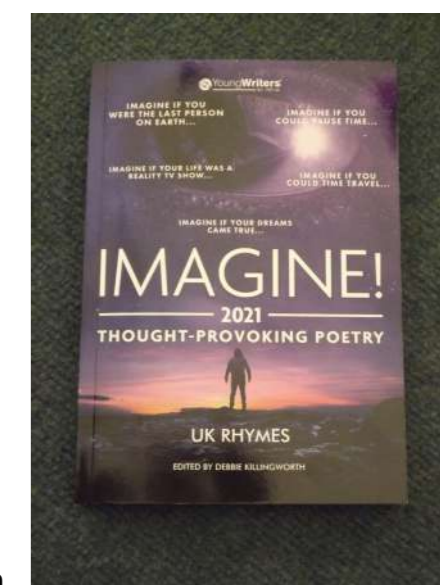

Kingsland Church are offering free packed lunches over the first week of the Christmas holidays for children and young people.


