ART COURSEWORK COLLECTION

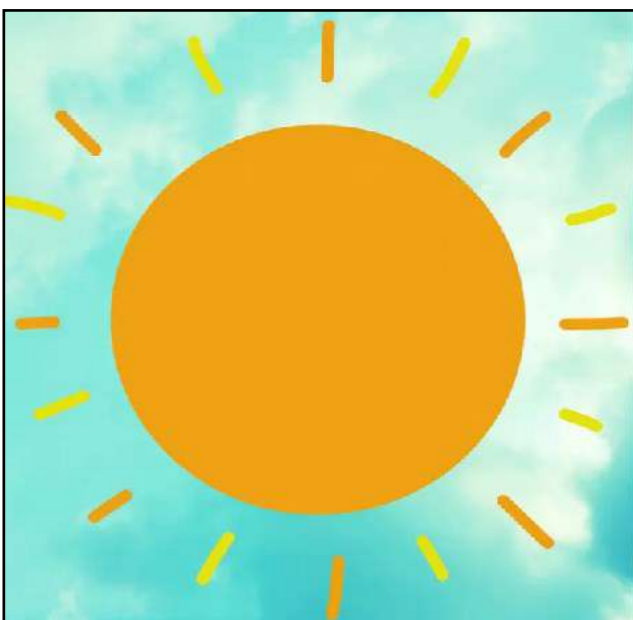
Ex students can now collect their Art coursework.
