

Welcome to the new term—we hope you all had a lovely Christmas break.



YEAR 11 DRESS UP DAY








Last term, the Diversity Hub held many successful campaigns, including Disability Awareness Day, where students put together a tutorial for all year groups to raise the profile of different disabilities.


