


CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS

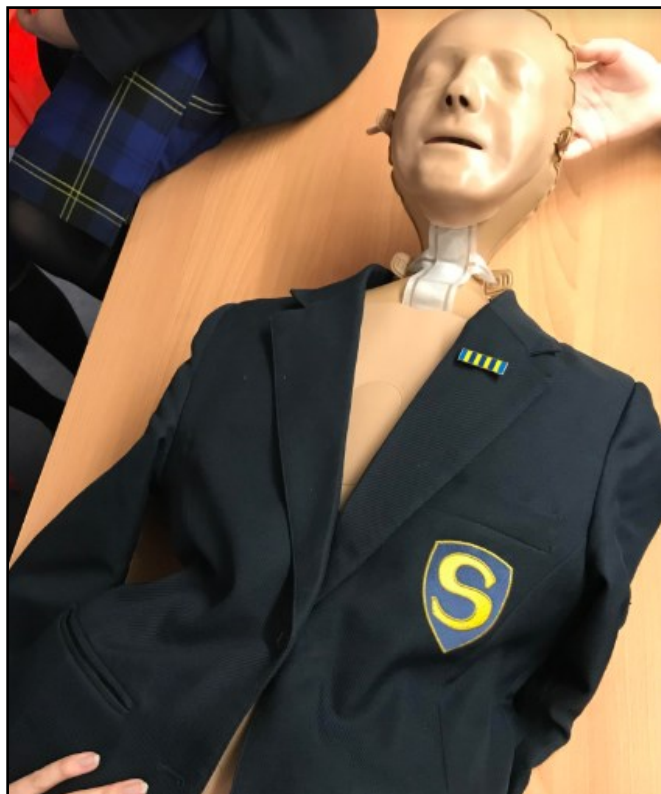
The school will be closed from Monday 23rd December until Wednesday 1st January inclusive.

FIRST AID CLUB



On Wednesday, 4th December we had our last First Aid Club meeting. Students have learnt how to call 999 and practise answers to the types of questions they would be asked, how to cope in an emergency and also how to use the DRSABC action plan (Danger, Response, Shout/Summon help, Airway, Breathing, CPR).

They have learnt how to perform CPR, how to use a defibrillator, when to use the recovery position, as well as dealing with choking, bleeding, asthma attacks and anaphylaxis.

I am extremely proud of them all and we now have 22 students in the school who have their Student First Aid Level 1 certificate.
