Beginners with no experience are welcome and there is lots of scope to progress to more advanced levels.

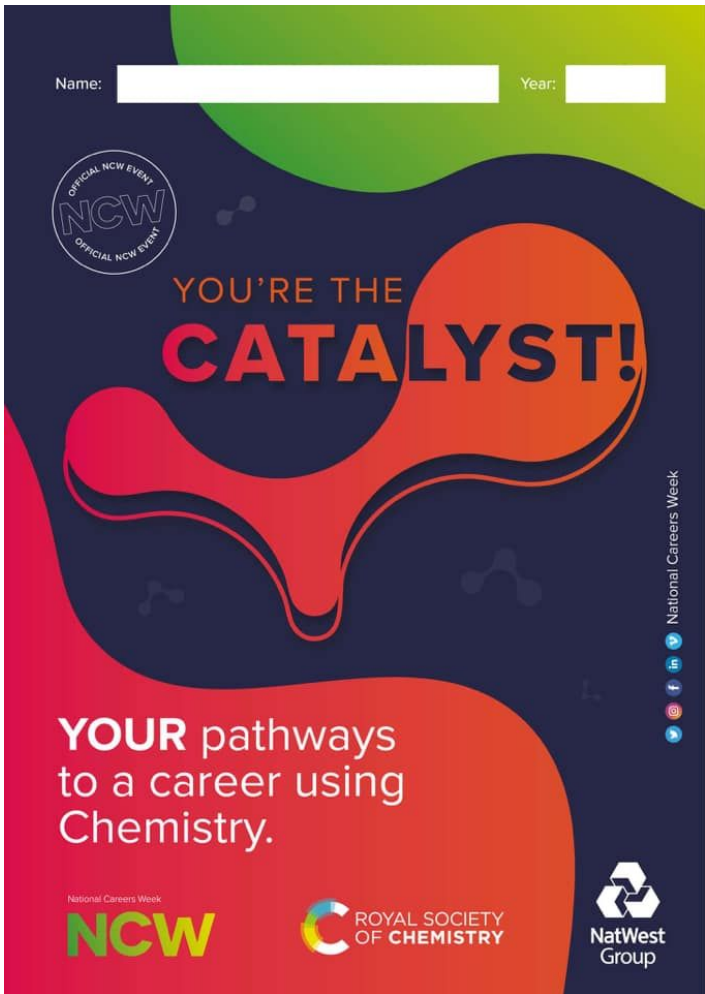
