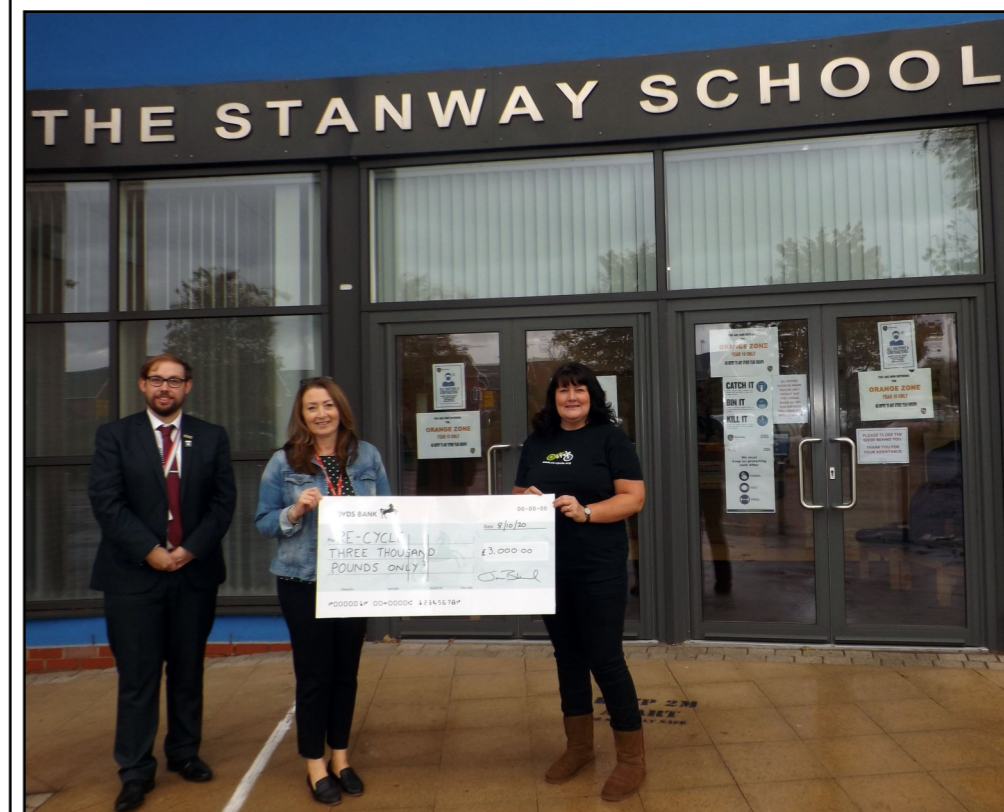
CHARITY DONATIONS
