This event is free to attend but you will need to have a pre-booked ticket. Spaces are limited so book now to avoid disappointment. Parking is also free of charge.

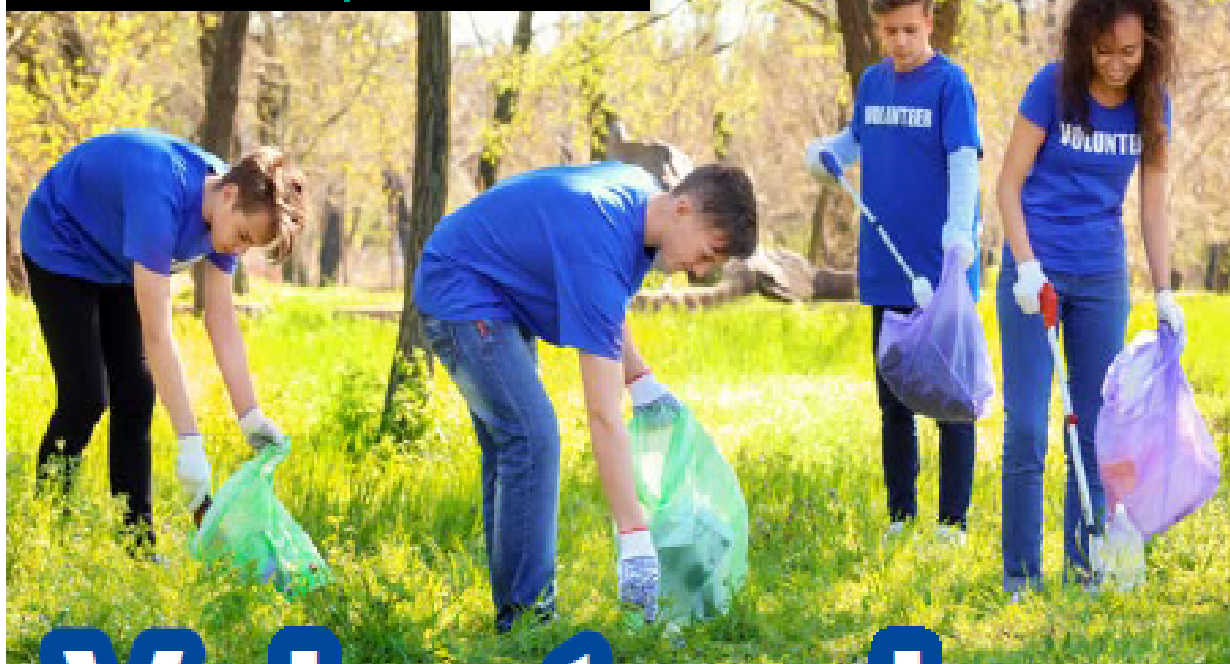
Due to the animals on-site and health & safety concerns, we are not allowing dogs to attend this event.
