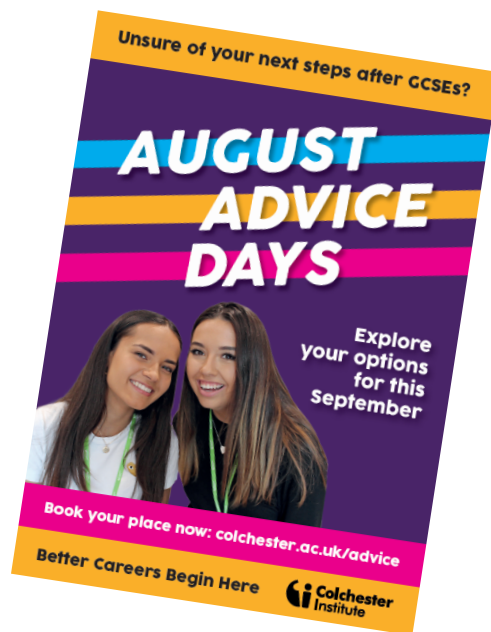

Announcing our Summer Advice Sessions

For 2021 our advice sessions will be physical, with August Advice days scheduled to take place from the 12th August. Here, you can explore alternative options if still unsure of your pathway or have decided on a change of direction.

Being physical events, we require you to book for specific appointment times to come and speak with tutors, therefore ensuring the health and safety of all attendees. Colchester Institute remains vigilant in the protection of all



its staff, students and visitors and therefore this method of welcoming members of the public will be in place. There will be no opportunity for people to purely walk up – **all attendance will be strictly by appointment only, bookable via the link below.**

Numbers of guests will also be restricted per appointment to you and one other attendee.

Due to the popularity of our study programmes it is highly recommended that you book your appointment early as courses are subject to closure once they are full.

On results day, you will be sent an enrolment form to the email address you put on your application form. This will be a simple form to fill in stating that you met entry requirements (5 grade 5s at GCSE or more for the A-Level pathway and 5 grade 4s or more for the BTEC Sport pathway) and that you accept your place. You will be sent an Admissions form to complete via the same email. Details regarding the start of college will be sent to you at the end of August. You do not need to do anything else.
