Year 10 HT 1	<b>AQA Christianity Beliefs Teachings - Life and Ministry of Jesus.</b> The crucifixion and resurrection and beliefs about life after death
Year 10 HT 2	<b>AQA Theme B Religion and Life</b> Religion and Science, the environment, the concept of sanctity of life and how this relates to beliefs about animal testing, abortion and euthanasia
Year 10 HT 3	<b>Christian Practices</b> Students will continue with Christian Practices as outlined in the AQA Religious Studies A GCSE Specification. This will include looking at worship, prayer, pilgrimage, baptism, the eucharist, evangelism and the role of the world church in fighting poverty
Year 10 HT 4	Option students will continue to work on Christian practices and then move on to Theme D Peace and Conflict which includes different religious responses to the use of violence. They will look at pacifism and Just War theory alongside lesser Jihad and the nuclear deterrent.
Year 10 HT 5	<b>Theme D Peace and Conflict</b> This includes different religious responses to the use of violence. They will look at pacifism and Just War theory alongside lesser Jihad and the nuclear deterrent.
Year 10 HT 6	<b>AQA Islam Beliefs and Teachings</b> The concept of Tawhid, the Nature of Allah, belief in angels, the importance of the Quran and the prophets, the difference between Sunni and Shia Islam
