

The Options Process

The Key Stage 4 programme will be made up of a mixture of 'Core' subjects and 'Option' subjects.

Core Subjects

- English Language
- English Literature
- Mathematics
- Science most do Trilogy
 (2 GCSEs covering all 3 sciences), some will do 3 separate GCSEs in Biology, Chemistry and Physics

Key Stage 4 Pathways

There are three 'Pathways' for students at Key Stage 4:

- 1) The English Baccalaureate Pathway (KS2 107+)
- 2) The Open Pathway
- 3) The Supported Pathway (by invitation only)

We have allocated students to the most appropriate pathway. This pathway will determine how they can choose their options.

The English Baccalaureate Pathway

This pathway ensures a well balanced curriculum that will keep your options open.

It's the expected pathway for students with KS2 Reading or Average scores of 107+ as national data shows they tend to achieve strong grades across the EBacc subjects.

Types of Courses

GCSEs (General Certificate of Secondary Education) are qualifications you take in a variety of subjects in Year 11. They are a stepping stone to lots of other careers and qualifications.

They are **predominantly assessed by exams** at the end of Year 11.

Some have coursework elements.


Some of our courses are called Vocational Awards, Technical Awards, OCR Cambridge Nationals or BTECs. These are more 'applied' qualifications, each equivalent to one GCSE. They still have final exams, but coursework completed during Year 10 and 11 counts very significantly to your grade.

- BPE, Citizenship, Computer Science
- Art, Drama, Graphics, Music, Music Tech
- Dance, GCSE PE or NCFE Health and Fitness
- Food or Catering, Technology, Construction

- Media Studies, Travel & Tourism
- Child Development, Health & Social Care
- Statistics, Further Mathematics with Statistics

• Their allocated pathway (EBacc, Open or Support) will be built into the form. You return the form online.

 You need to be logged into the student's school Google account to return the form (log into google.com first)

Deadline to return forms by is Friday 28th
 March 2025. (This will give you first priority.)

Reserve choice and reasons

- We do our best to give everyone their original choices,
 and this usually works for the vast majority of students
- However, as well as the main pathway choices, the forms ask for one additional reserve (backup) choice
- Just in case: we ask now so it's carefully considered, not a rushed/panic decision later on if we come to need it
- We also ask for the reasons behind all your choices

General Advice

- Rule of three: enjoy, succeed and continue
- Try to get a good breadth & balance of subjects (keep longer term options open)
- Never base a choice on teachers or friends
- Speak to subject teachers and form tutors
- Talk things over at home
- See our Careers Advisor and Post-16 providers (available in the canteen this evening)
